

Kittelson Mission Update 2020-04-26


I can do all things through him who strengthens me. Philippians 4:13

We are thankful that Taiwan has continued to keep the Covid-19 Virus under control with a very low count of infections. Most of the newly diagnosed cases are from citizens returning from abroad. There are few restrictions on our daily activities. Larger churches, like Victory LB Church in Hsinchu, are still not using their buildings for worship, but are beginning to allow small groups to use the building with a clear policy that provides for the safest environment possible. Other smaller churches are still meeting for worship. In regards to regular life, we go about freely. The greater the number of people we are around when we go out will determine if we put on a mask. In public buildings a mask is required. We are thankful that we have the possibility of greater protection because the Taiwan government, through the National Health Insurance program, provides surgical masks for all on their program.

With that said we remind you that we seek, like Luther during the time of the plague, to not carelessly put ourselves in harm's way, but to wisely travel about doing the normal things of life. We choose to limit where we go so as not to endanger ourselves, possibly be infected by another, resulting in personally getting sick or causing us to not be available to another in times of need. We do however make ourselves available to encourage those in need. We seek to use each day to prepare and minister to others even if it's from a distance.

We have enjoyed nice weather on Saturday mornings so the Victory Hakka Fellowship can gather in a nearby park to worship and encourage one another. Strangely our attendance has been better than when we were meeting in the building. We prepared a card to remind people who have needs that we will meet them in whatever environment they would feel comfortable to see someone face to face. This week we finished recording the Easter Booklet we use during this time so these mp3 files can be helpful for individuals in their homes. Now we will move on to other projects that can be recorded.

We praise God the Father for opportunities to bring His love to those around us, to His beloved children and those yet to be introduced to Jesus. Pray for next Saturday in the park. We





will have a Mother's Day theme. Usually we go out to eat, so we need a creative idea how to make it special. Pray also for the ministry using recordings and thumb drives that people will receive and use the messages to receive the peace of God in their hearts.
